

EKG Class Overview

In Person EKG class

Welcome to the EKG Technician course! This class is designed to provide you with the essential knowledge and hands-on skills needed to perform electrocardiograms (EKGs), a vital diagnostic tool used to assess heart health. You'll learn how to accurately place electrodes, operate EKG machines, interpret basic rhythms, and ensure patient comfort and safety throughout the process. Whether you're starting your career in healthcare or expanding your clinical skills, this course will prepare you to become a confident, competent EKG technician ready to make a difference in patient care.

Price: The price for the **online version** of the EKG class is **\$575**. If you would like to do the **class in person** for EKG the total cost is **\$675**. **If you cannot pay in full, a minimum amount of \$300 is required before the start of the program. Payment plans will be made thereafter until the program is paid in full.** Certification and completion of the course cannot be achieved until the program is paid in full.

Work Assignments: **Online version:** For the online version of the EKG class all assignments, quizzes, & tests will be completed online. Power Points will be delivered via email. The power points are simplified so you are not overwhelmed with excessive pages of reading materials. Quizzes & test will be sent out once you complete the power point module.

In person: For the in-person class you will go over the power points, quizzes, and assignments with the instructor in class. You **MUST** pass all quizzes and tests with at least a **grade of 70%** or better. If you happen to fail a quiz or test you are allowed a second attempt.

Clinicals: During the online program you will be **required** to attend hands on training in class of clinicals. Hands on training days are Wednesday and Friday. During clinicals you will be practicing patient preparation, electrode placement, operating the EKG machine, rhythm strip interpretation and any other questions you would like to go over during that time. Clinicals are done in the classroom.

Certification: Once you have completed the program with a passing grade and have attended all clinicals, you will receive a certification of completion and be considered a certified EKG technician. After you have received your certification, it is highly recommended that you sign up to take the national certified phlebotomy test to receive your license. You are able to get a position as a EKG tech however it is recommended that you obtain your license as it is preferred by employers.

License: After completion of the program and EKG TECH certification is obtained, you are eligible to sign up to take the state exam to obtain your license. You are eligible to sign up for the exam through the program. You will also receive study guides to prepare for the NPCE.
